Charge 1st Neglect of Duty:

Specification 1st In absenting himself ^{without leave} from the Sick of the
Reg^t. on the 18th & 19th September last when under march-
-ing orders from Sandy Hook;

Specification 2^d In absenting himself ^{without leave} from
the Sick of the Reg^t. (between 50 & 65 in number) while in
Tents near Fort Lewis Long Island from the 11th October to
the 19th same Month;

Specification 3^d. In abandoning the Hospital & Public Stores
appertaining to it, at the Garrison of Sandy Hook, on the
18th September last

Specification 4th In ~~refusing~~ ^{neglecting} to attend and administer Med-
-icine to the Wife & Child of the Sergeant Majors Fam-
-ily on or about the 24th August last then in Garrison at
Sandy Hook;

Specification 5th In not attending upon Lieut^{ts} Cooper, Tay-
-lor & Cross, when sick near Fort Lewis in September
& October 1814

Specification 6th In not commuting the Whiskey and
Rations of the Sick for their relief & comfort as directed;

Charge 2nd Disobedience of orders:

Specification 1st In not accompanying the Sick of the
Regiment when placed under his Special care, on
Board the Transport Sloop Fox, on the 18th September;
from Sandy Hook to N. Utrecht.
