An Act to enable the Governor to make a detachment of the Militia and for other purposes -

13  
Sect 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Delaware in General Assembly Met, That the Governor as Commander in Chief of the Militia of this State, be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to take effectual measures for drafting the Persons who shall compose the Proportion of this State of the detachment of one hundred thousand Militia required by the act of Congress entitled "An Act to authorize a detachment from the Militia of the United States" passed on the sixth day of February in the year eight hundred and twelve; That in carrying into effect this act, the Governor shall cause the Militia to be recalled in those company Districts where from the loss of Returns or other causes, the same may in his opinion be necessary to be done

Sect 2 And be it enacted, That the Governor is hereby authorized and empowered to ascertain the

be necessary to be provided for carrying into effect  
the call made upon this State in pursuance of  
the said Act of Congress; and to make contracts

for purchasing the same to be submitted for  
the approbation of the General Assembly at its next  
session: Provided however that the said Contracts  
may be immediately fulfilled by the Governor  
on the Part of this State without a submission  
of them to the General Assembly, if before the next  
B session thereof, war should ensue between the United  
States and any European Nation; and in that  
event the Treasurer is hereby authorized, empowered  
and required to obtain upon Loan from any  
of the Banks of this State any sum not exceeding  
twenty five thousand dollars, provided the same  
can be had at a Rate not exceeding the usual Bank  
discount allowed by law; and if a sum sufficient,  
with the money in the Treasury unappropriated, to raise  
22 the said twenty five thousand dollars cannot be  
obtained upon Loan, then the said Treasurer shall  
dispose of so much of any of the Funds of this State,
