The Court met agreeable to the above order & after being duly sworn proceeded to the Trial of John Fowler a private in the 6th Reg: on the following charge & Specification -

Charge 1st Unsoldier like Conduct -

Specification 1st In that the said John Fowler while on Drill on the morning of the 16th Inst. behaved in a disorderly manner -

To which charge & Specification the prisoner pleads not guilty.

Sergeant Fealing being duly sworn says that on the morning of the 16th that he observed that the company performed the Manual exercise worse than ever he had seen them. John Fowler made answer. he would not try to do any better.

John Alexander being sworn says that he heard the prisoner say he could not do his exercise any better. The Court after mature deliberation find the prisoner not guilty and order him to return to his duty. The Court then proceeded to the Trial of Jacob Byrick a private in Lieut-Taylor's Comp^y.

on the following charges & Specifications -

Charge 1st. Unsoldier like Conduct. Specification. In that the said Jacob Eyriks on the morning of the 16th Inst. came to Lieut Sisk's Market and behaved in a disorderly manner and when ordered away by Lieut Sisk made use of insolent language in reply -

Charge 2^d. Disrespect to Lieut Sisk

Specification. In that the said Jacob Eyriks when on fatigue on the morning of the 16th Inst. being asked by a Soldier if he had got out of the Guard Tent. replied that he would not give a dam for any officer who would take the part of a Negro. thereby insinuating that Lieut Sisk had taken undue advantage of him and making use of other impertinent expressions. To which charges & Specifications the prisoner the Prisoner Pleas not Guilty. Lieut Evans being sworn says that Jacob Eyriks came in quest of a pan to Lieut Sisk's Market and was ordered away by Lieut Sisk. heard him speak disrespectfully of Lieut Sisk but did not hear what he said -

Question by the Court -

What was the business the Prisoner had at Lieut Sisk's Market
answ^r in quest of a Pan. -

Question why was he refused the pan. -

answ^r. Because it was claimed by Lieut Sisk's Black Boy. the witness says to the sec^d Specification that he heard the prisoner say when asked by a soldier if he had got out of the Guard Tent. that he would not give a dam for any officer who would take a Negro's part. and further saith not.

The Court after mature deliberation find the prisoner not guilty of the first charge & first specification & not guilty of the second charge & first specification -

The observations heard by Lieut Evans were after he was sometime a prisoner. The Court do not know that they had any bearing on any officer or Non Commissioned officers which would subject the prisoner to punishment. and order him to return to his duty -

The Court Adjourned sine Die
